Transportation and Logistics

Minimise waste by evaluating delivery schedules and operations ensuring efficiency where possible. Take steps to improve environmental efficiency to minimise carbon emissions of our transport fleet, including minimising the age of vehicles in operational fleet and training drivers in driving in the most economical manner.

We actively promote recycling amongst our suppliers and customers. We stipulate that all vehicles utilised are well maintained and serviced efficiently.

We ensure that all vehicles are serviced and maintained in reputable local service centres.

Office

We will reduce the amount of energy used in the office and switch off lights or regulate via a timer where possible.

Heating and insulation of offices is reviewed to ensure the most efficient use of energy.

We will have a registered waste management collection system pushing where possible recycling of any sign manufacturing waste products.

We will seek to minimise the amount of paper used in the office and maximise the use of digital solutions

We avoid where possible the use of single use plastics. Refillable water bottles are provided to operational staff where possible.

Travel

Driving is necessary for travelling to and from work, although bike cycle parking is provided on-site for use where possible.

Client Meetings are only attended where measures cannot be taken to carry out the meeting via online video conferencing.

As we strive for excellence in every aspect of our business we are totally committed to minimising the environmental impacts of our business operation.


As part of this commitment we will ensure this Policy is reviewed and updated as necessary.
